In today's digital era, availability of published articles in digital mode has become a bare necessity for an illustrious journal like *Science and Culture*. DOI identifies the object (read article in the present case) digitally. DOI is a string of numbers, letters and symbols assigned to permanently identify an article or document and link it to the web. DOI of an article increases its visibility because readers can now easily locate a document digitally through web search.
