P.C. VAIDYA, A GANDHIAN MATHEMATICIAN-PHYSICIST AND PROPONENT OF 'VAIDYA METRIC': NEARLY IN OBLIVION

The year 2018 marked the birth centenary of the Gandhian mathematician-cum-physicist, P.C.
