

INDIAN NOMINATORS AND NOMINEES FOR THE PEACE NOBEL PRIZE IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE TWENTIETH CENTURY

Documents of the Peace Nobel Committee have been analysed to show who are the Indian nominators and nominees for the Peace Nobel Prize in the first half of the twentieth century. The nomination practice and geographical distribution of the Indian nominators are discussed. With the example of Gandhi's case, it is shown, how differently the Peace Nobel Committee and some of the Norwegians observed Gandhi's achievements.
