Influence of Plant Extracts in The Control of Bacterial Diseases

ABSTRACT: The effect of twenty plant extracts on the growth of Bacillus subtilis, Escherichia coli and Pseudomonas aeruginosa was evaluated. The growth inhibition of all three bacterial species was around 70-80%. Hyptis a suaveolens, a notorious weed in Southern India was very effective and completely inhibited the bacterial growth. Murraya paniculata and Mentha viridis were quite effective in checking the growth of B.subtilis and P.aeruginosa. A medicinal plant Datura stramonium was not so effective in controlling the bacterial growth. Momordica charantia, a medicinal vegetable was moderate in its action against three bacterial species.
