## SENGA SILCHARENSIS, A NEW CESTODE SPECIES FROM THE INTESTINE OF THE FRESH WATER FISH CHANNA PUNCTATUS (BLOCH) FROM CHATLA HAOR, SILCHAR, ASSAM

Senga silcharensis, a new cestode species from the intestine of the fresh water fish Channa punctatus (Bloch) has been described and compared with the other known species of the genus Senga in the lunes of work by Dollfus (1934). It differs from all the known species of the genus in the number of hooks, testes and shape of the scolex.
