## VITAMIN C FROM HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE TO WONDER MOLECULE OF TWENTY FIRST CENTURY

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The discovery of wonder molecule vitamin C is closely related to the history of ancient disease scurvy. This disease was very common among the sailors, soldiers and some other persons who did not have the privilege of consuming fresh vegetables and citrus fruits in their diets.
